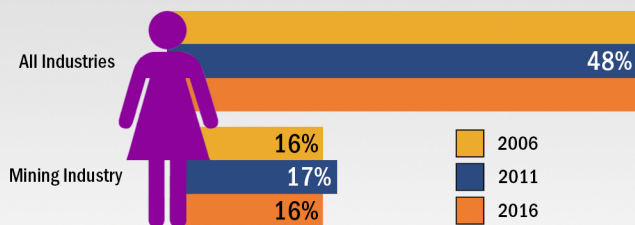

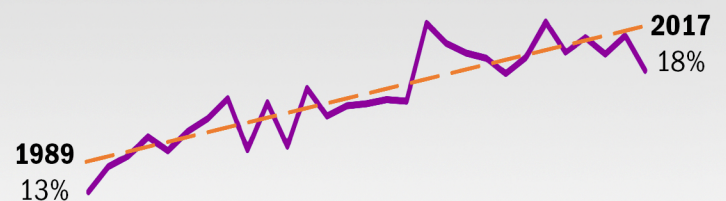

Representation of Women in the Mining Industry



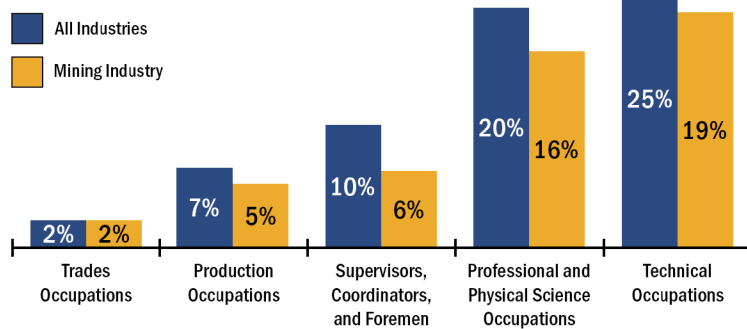

Representation of Women in Mining, Quarrying and Oil and Gas Extraction



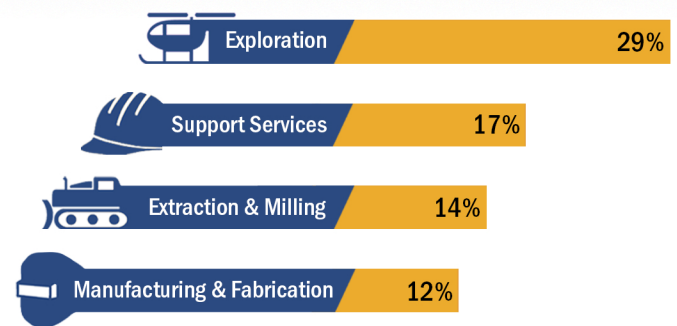

Representation of Women in the Labour Force by Broad Occupation



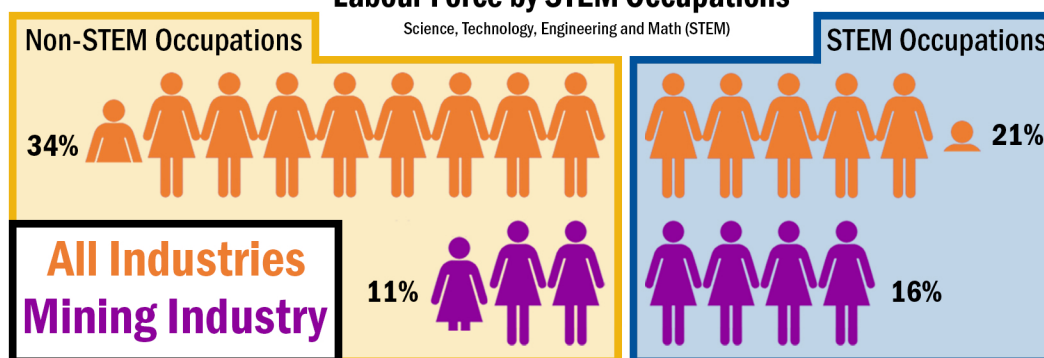

Representation of Women in the Mining Industry's Sub-sectors

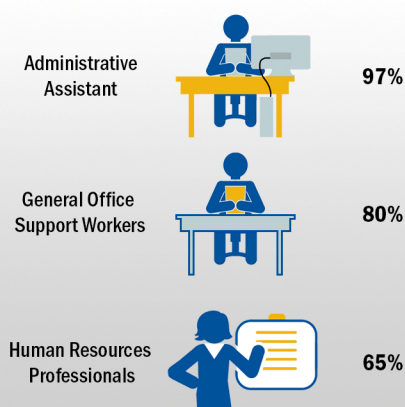


Share of Women in the Mining Labour Force by STEM Occupations²

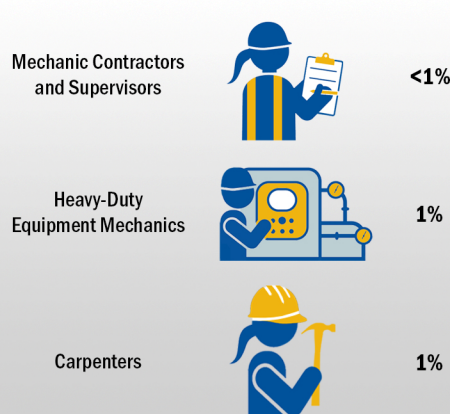

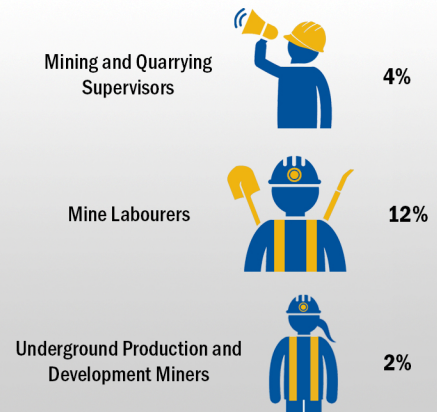
Mining Jobs with the Highest Percentage of Women²
